EPISODIC SYNOPSIS

CHOCOLATE

In the middle of a tropical forest in Brazil, a family lives in the middle of a cocoa plantation. In Costa Rica, a journalist discovers how chocolate was born. In Belgium, a chocolatier opens his kitchen and reveals his creations. Do Belgians make the best chocolate in the world? In London, a specialist fulfills her childhood dream and works tasting chocolates. In Bali, an Australian discovers the cocoa fruit and in Hong Kong we visit an exhibition of sculptures made with chocolate.

COMFORT

In Brazil, a young executive realizes that she is stuck in a comfort zone. In Mexico City, a therapist relieves people of stress with the help of sound. In Amsterdam, a masseuse finds an unusual way to comfort her clients. In Copenhagen, a family explains the meaning of the word Hygge.

DANCE

In Spain, the flamenco tradition is passed from generation to generation in a school for children. In Tokyo, a secretary finds the pleasure of living in Tango. On the outskirts of the fourth largest city in the world, young people meet to dance in a competition that mixes street dancing and personal identity. In India, a dancer shows the effort and work to achieve mastery in her art.

LAUGH

Traveling across the border between Mexico and the United States, we see the work of Clowns Without Borders, who bring laughter to people who have no reason to laugh. In Hong Kong, we followed a Laughter Yoga session and in Costa Rica a psychologist teaches us how to have a better life with the help of laughter.

SEX

In Brazil, a middle-class couple discovers the pleasure of tantric sex. In France, an erotic comic book author recalls his relationships with his models. In Amsterdam, a woman tells us about her personal experience with sex, the city and the streets of the Red-Light District. In Mexico, a young doctor makes the connection between sex, discoveries and freedom. In Buenos Aires, a writer challenges our beliefs about sex and old age.

TRAVEL

The first man to have been to every UN country tells us what he learned from his travels. A Frenchman develops totally unusual and different ways of traveling. A South African family living outside their country learns that to get to know the culture of a place, you must live there. Several wanderers in the world tell us why to travel.

WATER

In southern Spain, a group of friends get together every morning to watch the sun rise over the sea while swimming in the Mediterranean. In Japan a man meditates under a waterfall, a centuries-old tradition. In Brazil, a family goes to the beach to have fun. In Michigan a therapist treats his patients with the help of water. In Bali, a young priestess shows the magic in the water.
